Beware! Scams are on the rise!

The FTC has information concerning current potential scams. Some of the current ones are romance scams, student loan and education scams, gift card scams, social security/IRS impersonators, and tech support scams.

Members! When mailing in a deposit or payments, you do not need deposit slips. Including a note with specific transaction instructions will ensure your transaction is processed correctly.

Please verify you are using the correct account number/format and corresponding account type (savings/checking) when giving your account information for online payments or direct deposits.

Your Share Savings account is your primary number but your Share Draft (checking) account number is located at the bottom of your checks and is 14 digits long.

If you are using the wrong information there is a chance of your deposit or payment posting to the wrong account, or being returned for no account. We try to manually process these but sometimes are unable to do so. This could potentially cause return fees and late payments or your payroll to be returned to your employer.

If at any time you are unsure of what numbers to use, please call the office and let us help you!! This will ensure your transactions are completed in the most timely and efficient manner as possible!

Financial Fitness

Every penny counts! Consider keeping most of your money in an interest-bearing savings account. Even low-interest savings accounts earn more money than zero-interest checking accounts. Of course you need to have enough in checking to pay bills, but many people store most of their savings in the checking account where they earn no interest!

Put aside money for emergencies! Most financial advisors suggest a minimum of three to six months living expenses set aside. Some even suggest ensuring this savings before paying down debt!

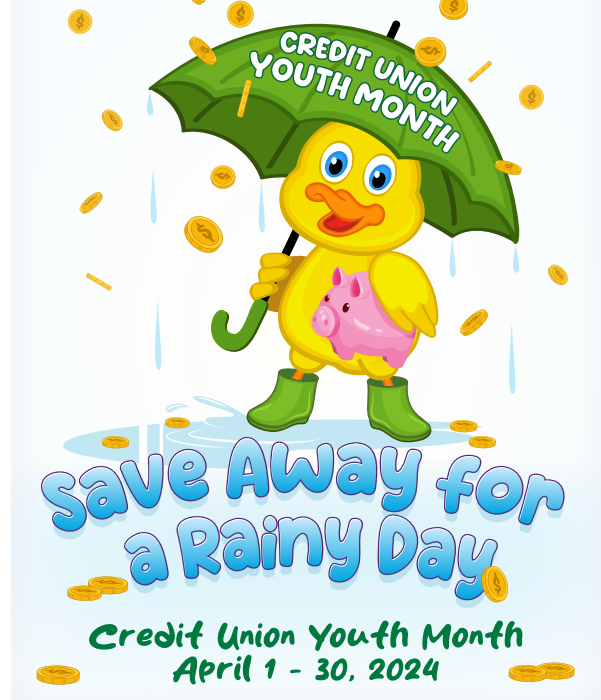
