

ANNUAL MEETING RECAP

The Credit Union's Annual Meeting was once again held at the Franklin Firehouse on Saturday, April 28, 2018. Seventy-five members were in attendance and enjoyed morning refreshments at the 9:30AM Meet and Greet.

The Business meeting was called to order at 10:00AM by Vice President Joseph Walsh, who filled-in for retiring President David Williams. Joe remarked on some of the events the Credit Union has taken part in for community service including "Shred-It" Day and Secret Santa for Senior Citizens, as well as donations and sponsoring other events. The Credit Union continues to offer Scholarship Awards to qualifying high school seniors.

Treasurer Sue Giudice gave her report commenting on the income the Credit Union has made in the last two years and that income from investments had increased. She stressed that shares continue to grow and loans had been declining, some due to lack of loan demand and others due to delinquencies for various reasons. She complimented the staff and the great job they do being unique and well-rounded as that everyone has their primary position but also must be cross trained in another area to cover for that person if need be.

Supervisory Committee Chairman Joseph Grieco gave his report. He complimented the other members of his committee on the excellent job they do. He commented that both the Annual Supervisory Auditor and the NCUA Federal Examiner complimented the Supervisory Committee, Board of Directors, Management and staff on the good job they do running the Credit Union.

Old and New Business was discussed. The Nominating Committee presented the slate of nominees for the Board of Directors. Incumbents Joseph Walsh, Sue Giudice and Rosarie Avila were re-elected for two year terms. Mark Luettger was elected for the seat of retiring Board Member David Williams.

Vice President Walsh then acknowledged retiring Board President David Williams and thanked him for his many years of service which drew a standing ovation.

Door prizes including low interest rate loans were given away throughout the meeting.
